



Top 10 High Scores

This year we will post the "Top 10 Highest Score - Solos" & "Top 10 Highest Score - Groups" of each day at the end of each day. Whichever dances have made it into the final top 10 highest score position from the entire competition will be posted in the lobby at the Port Theatre at the end of the last session on May 11th. The final top 20 dances will be performing that night during the Gala. The top 20 dances must perform in the Gala in order to receive their prizes and CoreDance plaque.

The Gala will also include our Awards Ceremony during which our scholarships, prizes and money will be awarded to the deserving young dancers who have been selected by the adjudicators. This could be any dancer who has entered the competition. You do not need to be among the performers in the Gala to receive a scholarship or prize. However, to receive your scholarship or prize you must either be watching or performing in the gala and be present to hear your name announced during the showcase. If for some reason you are unable to attend the Gala, make sure you have a friend or family member present to accept your award(s) on your behalf.

Gala entry will be by donation with a min suggested donation of \$10.00 per adult and \$5.00 per youth (12>).

Gala Information for Top 10 Highest Score Winners

CHECK IN PROTOCOL:

- The backstage area and stage will be open a minimum of 1 hour before Gala commences.
- Sign in at the check in table when you arrive.
- Hand in your music at the sign in table once you have checked yourself in.
- Double check cues at sign in table – do you start and end on or off?
- Once you have checked in, the stage will be available for warm up and spacing.

AWARDS PROTOCOL:

Awards and plaques will be given out once each high score dance has performed. In order to receive your plaques and goodies please follow these instructions:

- All dances that finish on stage – lights will stay on - take a bow and come over to the front of stage right to accept your award.
- All dances finishing off stage – will have to immediately come back on stage to the front of stage right to accept your award.

At the end of the show, all performers will be asked to come back on stage for a final bow!

Note Make sure all cell phone numbers and representatives' numbers are updated on each registration form. We must be able to reach you on those numbers on May 11th. This ensures we are able to contact you if you have a top 10 placement or if you have received a scholarship.*
