COMPETITION

For your session:

1. Each dancer will perform their minute to minute and a half solo in their category.
2. At the end of the session the MC will call the top 3 dancers in each category and call them to stage for a "Dance off". The dancers MUST be in the audience and ready to come on stage when called.
3. They will then participate in the "Dance Off" for first, second and third place. Each dancer will have 45 seconds of time to freestyle.
4. After the "Dance Off" the winner of each category will be announced. The first place winners must return at the end of the night for the Final Dance Off for the Top Dancer Prize.

COREDANCE PRODUCTIONS DOES NOT WISH TO DISQUALIFY ANY PERFORMER AND SINCERELY ADVISES ALL COMPETITORS, PARENTS, TEACHERS, AND CHOREOGRAPHERS TO ABIDE BY THE REGULATIONS AND SPIRIT OF THE COMPETITION SO THAT INFRACTIONS DO NOT OCCUR. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INDEPENDENT REGISTRANTS TO MAKE SURE THE RULES IN THIS DOCUMENT ARE ENFORCED AND THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE AUDIENCE & FAMILIES TO INFORM THEMSELVES.

All parents, teachers, and students will hold the art of dance in the highest regard.

- There will be zero tolerance of derogatory statements concerning another studio or fellow dancer at any time.
- We hold a no-negativity rule and it is strictly enforced; anyone demonstrating non-compliance to this rule will be asked to leave the event.

CHECK IN

When you arrive at the competition for the first time:

Check that the sign in table has your cell number or the cell number of the individual who will be acting as the studio rep. CoreDance must be able to contact you in case of emergency.

- All dancers should be checked in by the time the session starts.

AGE DIVISIONS

All submitted registrations will use the **dancer's age as of November 4th, 2017.**

DON'T GET FINED OR HAVE A DANCE DISQUALIFIED!

All fines are payable in cash and must be made **before the adjudication of their session to the Rules & Regulations table** or the dance entry will be disqualified and will not be able to partake in the HardCore Finals.

- Any intentional damage or defacing of theatre property by a student **\$100, plus all charges incurred by the theatre for any cleaning and/or repair**
- Infringement of the family-friendly content rule in music & performance (swearing, inappropriate language/content/costuming) **\$50**
- Use of cameras, video cameras, camera phones, tapes, or recorders of any kind **\$50**
- Pay fines at the check-in table for dances that have been flagged.

MUSIC

- **Music will be played by the theatre staff and music must be submitted to DanceSync (<https://core.signup.dance/>) at time of registration.**
- Music Choice must be edited for inappropriate language & content. Content must be appropriate for a family audience. Dancers must also fade the music out between 1 min and 1 min and a half.
- The Judges, in consultation with CoreDance, will decide if the language or content is inappropriate.

AWARDS

Top 3 Scores for each category will be selected by the judges to freestyle at the "Dance Off"

Prizes:

1. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place (cash prize for 1st place) for each category
2. Audience Appreciation during freestyle "Dance Off" each session
3. Random Judges' Choice Awards
4. Top Dancer Award from Final "Dance Off" between all 1st place winners
 - Cash Prize, merchandise and trophy!
